# Confirmation Guidelines (2017-2018) St. Mary's & St. Augustine Catholic Communities

**What is Confirmation?** It is the completion of your baptismal choice—you confirm the faith commitment made for you at your Baptism

# What three decisions will you be making?

- (1) To commit yourself to the preparation program- all classes and retreat times, service projects, etc.
- (2) To say "yes" to confirming your faith in your heart and in the daily living choices that you will make the rest of your life. This is a free will choice to saying yes.
- (3) To publicly celebrate Confirmation, that is, to participate in the public sacramental ceremony in which you express your "yes" before God, the Bishop, and the faith community

### NATURE OF THE PREPARATION:

Participate in the introductory session with your parent(s) on Wednesday September 13 at 7:30PM at St. Mary's Corpus Christi Center.

- 1. Participate in youth group/Confirmation classes during youth group regularly.
- 2. Attend the formal enrollment of candidates at Mass **on Sunday October 1**st **at 8AM.** Please attend with your sponsor if at all possible.
- 3. Complete a minimum of twenty-five (25) hours of free service. Candidates are to do some service within the parish communities, some in their families and some in the larger civic community.
- 4. Turn in assignments or projects as requested and on time.
- 5. Be interviewed by Fr. Louis at the end of preparation regarding the completion of the above and your desire to celebrate or not to celebrate the sacrament of Confirmation.
- 6. Choose a sponsor who can "be there" for you during this confirmation process and hopefully as you continue your journey of faith through life. Your sponsor MUST be a practicing Confirmed Catholic in good standing with the Catholic Church.
- 7. Write a letter to Bishop Jim Powers asking for the Sacrament of Confirmation.
- 8. Attend a retreat provided by St. Mary's date and time to be determined later. This will be an overnight retreat offsite.

#### **SPONSOR**

- 1. A confirmed, practicing Catholic not a parent (can be a baptismal godparent)
- 2. Someone who can be a supportive friend, preferably a local person

## **ROLE OF SPONSOR**

- 1. Assist in preparations- discuss class material and activities, do service together
- 2. Attend as many classes with the candidate as possible. (if possible, not mandatory)
- 3. Attend the Enrollment Mass on Sunday October 1st at 8AM
- 4. Help the candidate live out his/her Catholic faith by example and support
